Capistrano Valley High School Activities Behavior Contract

Both parent/guardian and student, (even if student is 18+) must read, understand, initial (12X) and sign this agreement

All students attending Capistrano Valley High School (CVHS) activities, on or off campus, are expected to know that appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by CVHS. Activities include but are not limited to: formal and semi-formal dances, athletic events, senior activities, banquets, pep rallies, performing arts events, camps, field trips, lunch activities, intramural sports, etc. Please refer to Capistrano Unified School District Student Information Handbook for detailed information and consequences. All students and parents should be aware of the following regarding school activities:

1. **Students must be dressed appropriately at all times.** This is a district wide dress/grooming standard. Students that are out of compliance with these standards, on the first offense will not be allowed into any dance/activity. Students must always wear a shirt and pants or the equivalent, or a dress or skirt and shoes. On subsequent offenses parents will be contacted to bring appropriate attire or to pick up the student. Collared shirts are required for semi-formal dances, ties are required for formal dances.

These items are NOT allowed.

- Any items that contain offensive, illegal, violent, obscene symbols, signs, slogans, or words degrading any gender, culture, religion, ethnicity, race, or anything that may incite a negative response or conflict including reference to sex, drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
- Clothing or accessories considered unsafe, dangerous or a health hazard.
- Clothing that significantly and/or intentionally reveals undergarments.
- Items that obscure the face, except as a religious observance.

2. **All students must have a Capistrano Valley High School ID Card.** Students are expected to carry CVHS ID card with them on campus during school hours and at all school events/activities. When asked by a staff member, students must present their ID card immediately. Students are expected to keep their card in acceptable shape and not alter their card in any way. If a student loses the card he/she may purchase a replacement at the Activities Office.

3. **No profanity/vulgarity.** Students are expected to use appropriate language and refrain from gestures that are obscene or vulgar while at school or during school events and activities.

4. **All students are responsible for the cleanliness of the campus.** A student is considered to have littered if he/she leaves an area when trash has been left, whether or not it is his/her trash. Throwing food (or any object) is never acceptable. It is expected that students clean up after themselves, walk to a trashcan and drop trash into can. This includes biodegradable items.

5. **Assumption of Risk.** By its very nature, competitive, playful activities and athletics can put a student in situations where SERIOUS, CATASTROPIC and perhaps FATAL accidents may occur. Students and parents/guardians must assess and assume the risks involved in participation and make their choice to participate in spite of those risks. NO amount of instruction, precaution or supervision will completely eliminate all the risk of injury; participation in a CVHS activity could be inherently dangerous.

6. **No use of alcohol, controlled substance, tobacco or intoxicant of any kind.** According to Board Policy 5144.1 "students are to be recommended by the school principal for expulsion if they are found: possessing, using, distributing or being under the influence of any controlled substance, alcohol beverage, or intoxicant of any kind." The minimum consequence is a 5-day suspension and the loss of all student privileges for 2 semesters (i.e. participation in all extracurricular activities, co-curricular activities/privileges, on-campus parking, and senior activities and commencement ceremony, if applicable).

8. **All students must be respectful.** Any student whose behavior adversely affects the experience of another participant or performer (i.e. heckling, shouting, use of racial or other inappropriate epithets and slurs, rude audience etiquette, etc.) or damages property at any event will face consequences which may include suspension and/or exclusion from any school related activities.

9. **Dances.** In order to promote a healthy, safe enjoyable evening for all students, the following procedures will be in place for this dance: There is no admittance to the dance after the first hour nor may they leave more than one hour before the dance ends, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Activities Director. Attendees who leave the dance will not be readmitted. If a student is removed from the dance for any reason, it is the parent's responsibility to immediately pick up the student from the dance. Students will be breathalyzed and searched. Please Read & Understand that the **Dance Dress Code is STRICTLY Enforced***

*The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dress style. Questions/complaints about dress code will NOT be addressed at the dance. Student in violation of dress code will NOT be admitted into the dance. Students who are dressed inappropriately will be asked to call home for a change of clothes or must be picked up. If your dress is in question, send a picture of you in the dress to your Assistant Principal in the Administration office for approval prior to the dance.

- a. **All students and guests will be breathalyzed.** Security may conduct purse searches, "pat downs" and/or substance consumption tests. Any attendee who refuses to comply will be denied entry. Students who consume alcohol and/or any illegal substance before, during or after a dance will be removed, their parents will be called to escort the student home and the student may be recommended for expulsion according to Board Policy

- b. **Any vehicle may be searched.** ALL passengers in a vehicle will be held responsible for any illegal substance found in that vehicle. All party busses and limousines will be searched. If your group has 15 or more people, you will need to turn in a group transportation clearance form to the ASB office at least three days prior to dance.

- d. **Loud music and lighting will be in use.** It is the responsibility of attendees to protect themselves from auditory and/or visual sensitivity.

All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety. Inappropriate dancing or other sexually suggestive behavior is inappropriate and will result in removal from the dance (temporarily or permanently). The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dance style. 1st offense, wristband to be cut off and the student will be given an immediate 15 minute time out and a detention. 2nd offense, student will be removed from the dance, (parent must pick them up) and student will also lose future privileges (i.e. will not be able to walk in graduation; will not be able to attend future dances).

Tickets refunds **must be requested one week prior to dance.** Tickets may not be sold or transferred to another student.

Each student **MUST** present a **Capistrano Valley High School ID card at the Dance Check-In** table.

Guests must be approved by administration. A separate guest contract must be completed. All visiting guests must abide by CVHS Students rules/dress code/dance behavior etc. and the CVHS student is ultimately responsible for their guest at all times. Guests must provide the same identification that was submitted with their guest ticket contract. CVHS students bringing a guest must check in with their guest.
