### Is your service for everyone?

Yes, every student in CUSD, but initially our one-on-one services are geared towards high school students, grades 9 -12. Middle school or elementary students, and families, are more than welcome to attend our free group workshops, so visit [www.cusd-futureology.org/appointments-events](http://www.cusd-futureology.org/appointments-events).

### What services do you offer?

While a student's grade level determines the specific nature of our work together, our group workshops and one-on-one counseling services typically fall into one of these college and career "buckets" or service categories:

1. Best Fit College Search & Selection
2. Application Strategy & Assistance
3. Career Exploration & Planning
4. Financial Aid & Scholarship Support

### Does it cost money?

No, our one-on-one services and group workshops are at NO cost to CUSD students & families.

### How can I schedule a one-on-one or group guidance workshop or bootcamp?

All registrations must be made online. One-on-one's scheduling goes through our "calendly" system while workshops are typically registered through google docs. Register @

### Will I get a confirmation?

For one-on-ones, yes, directly from calendly including your time, date and pre-meeting questionnaire link. For events, email reminders are sent a few days before.

### Do I need to bring anything to my appointments?

No, however we ask that you complete a pre-meeting questionnaire before your appointment (sent in your confirmation email).

### When are you available?

We are available during the academic school year, Sept. through May, Monday - Friday from 3:30pm - 9pm.

### Can I just drop in?

No, in order to best serve our students (and manage our space requirements), we require scheduled one-on-one appointments.

### Do my parents need to be there (or does my child need to come)?

We encourage both parents and students to come, however the student MUST be present.

### Can I get help with picking my classes or making my 4-year plan?

Your Academic Advisor at your HS is your best source for the type of assistance such as course scheduling and selection, grad requirements, credit check, and 4-year planning. We typically will only help explore options based on your college and career goals.

### What if I miss my appointment?

You are able to reschedule. However, it could be a month or more before you are seen by one of our counselors. For your convenience, we send out reminders. Please don't "no show". Cancel well in advance.

### Can I schedule more than one appointment at a time?

Our sessions are based on milestone action items therefore we encourage families to schedule subsequent appointments after they have completed the action items.
