#### Honors Courses

- Honors courses are advanced paced, "weighted" classes.
- Since the UC GPA Calculation includes grade 9-12, 9th grade honors courses are recognized by the University of California System as "District Level" honors courses
- Honors courses have district placement guidelines.

# Advanced Course Offerings: Advanced Placement (AP)
